The Sikji (clock) and Sikji-gae (clock hanger) are traditional Korean decorative objects. The Sikji-gae is a colorful dragon-shaped frame that holds a circular metal gong (Sikji). The dragon is painted in shades of green, yellow, and red, with intricate details. Below the gong is a large, light blue, fan-shaped element, and at the base is a stylized turtle (Karyu) with a red saddle. The entire piece is mounted on a white wall.

The Sikji-gae is a traditional Korean decorative object. It is made of wood and metal. The dragon-shaped frame is painted in shades of green, yellow, and red. The gong is made of metal and has a circular design. The fan-shaped element is made of wood and is painted light blue. The turtle is made of wood and is painted grey with a red saddle.
